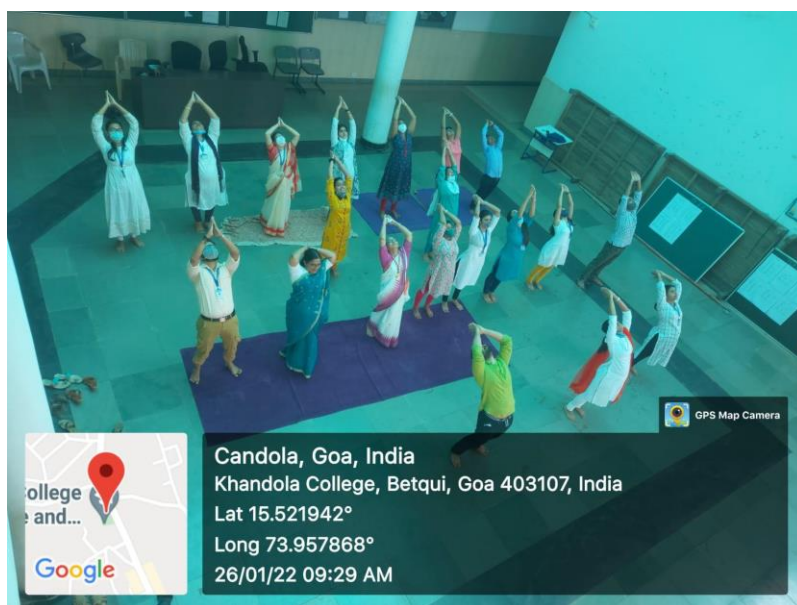


The following activities were held from September 2021 to June 2022.
