## Students' Council Report 2022-23

The Students' Council is a body consisting of student representatives, headed by the General Secretary and teacher representatives who work towards organising activities for the students of the college, such that they flourish in all fields of life. This academic year, the Council is headed by the General Secretary Ms. Shreya Naik (S.Y.B.COM), Mr. Syden Fernandes (S.Y.B.A.) is the Cultural secretary; Ms. Anjali Shinde (S.Y.B.SC.) is the Ladies Representative, Mr. Myron Pereira (S.Y.B.VOC.) is the Sports Secretary; along with various Class Representatives from respective classes.

The following is a summary of the events organised by the Students' Council for the academic year 2022-23:

• A patriotic singing interclass- competition was held on the 14 August 2022 in the spirit of the 75 Independence Day; wherein a total of 8 teams participated. The judges for the same were Ms. Pranisha Vernekar and Mr. Gaurang Bhandiye, both alumni of the college and pursuing music as their passion.
